


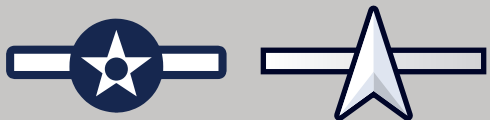

### VANDENBERG STRIPES



USAF General Vandenberg's 1952 E-2 Rank Insignia Proposal

USSF Specialist 2 Insignia Utilizing General Vandenberg's Stripe Model

General Vandenberg (for whom Vandenberg Space Force Base is named) proposed but never utilized this concept for Air Force Junior Enlisted stripes. We honor his vision with our modern rendition of the classic concept.

Space Force Specialist Stripes represent *terra firma*, a solid foundation of skills upon which the Space Force, represented by the Delta, is built.

### The Foundational Delta & Hexagonal Border

The Delta is the foundation for all USSF Enlisted Insignia, and begins with Specialist 1 where it is centrally featured. The six-sided border surrounding the insignia represents the USSF as the 6th Branch of the U.S. Armed Forces. The Hexagonal Border is used for all Enlisted Insignia.

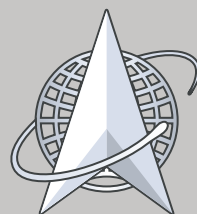

### SERGEANT CHEVRONS

Upholding & Serving the USSF






Originating from the Latin word *serviens*, 'one who serves', achieving the title of Sergeant brings with it an increased responsibility to serve those they are charged with caring for. This change is reflected in the traditional Sergeant chevrons that replace the straight-line stripes of a Specialist.



### The Delta, Globe, and Orbit (DGO)

The DGO represents the totality of our Space Force. Sergeants of the Space Force uphold our values, people, and mission. In recognition of this, their chevrons are placed accordingly, upholding the USSF.

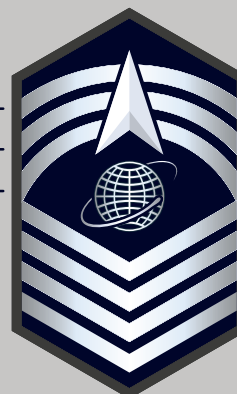

### The Delta Ascends



Senior Non-Commissioned Officers lead Enlisted Guardians from the front by taking on greater responsibilities. The Orbital Chevrons correlate with Low Earth, Medium Earth, and Geosynchronous Orbits as SNCOs progress through their development. The placement of the Delta above the Globe further signifies this higher level of responsibility while the Delta breaking through the Orbits shows their willingness to explore and innovate. The open space around the Orbital Chevrons signifies the vastness of the warfighting domain of Space and the limitless potential of our Space Force.
